



Update to the UK Sanctions List: UN ISIL (Da'esh) & Al-Qaida Sanctions Regime

Please be advised that an update has been issued to the UK Sanctions List. The Consolidated list of Financial Sanctions has also been updated. This notification is provided to ensure that all relevant persons under the jurisdiction of the Virgin Islands are informed promptly of these changes.

Details of the Update:

On Friday, 17 October 2025 the UK Government has amended 1 designation under the UN ISIL (Da'esh) & Al-Qaida Sanctions Regime. This reflects the amendment made by the UN Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) & Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee on 16 October.

- The following entry has been amended under the UN ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Regime (the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida (United Nations Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 and remains subject to sanctions:
