

Update to UK Sanctions List

Update to the UK Sanctions List: Global Human Rights

Today, 20 May, the UK Government has sanctioned 3 individuals and 4 entities under the Global Human Rights Sanctions Regime. This package targets 3 individuals, including prominent settler leader Daniella Weiss, as well as 2 illegal outposts and 2 organisations that have supported, incited and promoted violence against Palestinian communities in the West Bank.
