



Update to the UK Sanctions List: Russia Sanctions Regime

Please be advised that on 24 July 2025, the UK government has made administrative amendments to the designation of 1 entity and the specification of 1 ship, both sanctioned under the Russia sanctions regime..

Please be advised that an update has been issued to the UK Sanctions List. The Consolidated list of Financial Sanctions has also been updated. This notification is provided to ensure that all relevant persons under the jurisdiction of the Virgin Islands are informed promptly of these changes
