

Company Law Review Advisory Committee (CLRAC)

The Company Law Review Advisory Committee (“CLRAC”) was established pursuant to section 228A of the BVI Business Companies Act, 2004 (“the Act”) to continuously review the Act and any other enactments relating to company law, and recommend changes or reform to the Financial Services Commission (the “Commission”) on company law under the Act or any other relevant enactment. Members of the CLRAC reflect a cross section of representatives from within the industry and relevant public sector agencies with knowledge and experience of company law. Pursuant to section 228A(4) of the Act, the Managing Director of the Commission is the Chairman of the CLRAC.
