

Sanctions Circular No. <u>117</u> of 2025

International sanctions in force in the Virgin Islands are the same as those in force in the UK.

Financial Sanctions Notice

6 November 2025

Counter-Terrorism (Domestic)

Introduction

- 1. The Counter-Terrorism (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (S.I. 2019/577) were made under the Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018 ("the Sanctions Act") and provide for the imposition of financial sanctions, namely the freezing of funds and economic resources of persons who are or have been involved in terrorist activity.
- 2. On 6 November 2025 the Consolidated List was updated following HM Treasury's decision to designate 2 persons.
- 3. The Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office have also updated the UK Sanctions List on GOV.UK. This list provides details of those designated under regulations made under the Sanctions Act.

What you must do in relation to this Financial Sanctions Notice

5. You must:

- I. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice.
- II. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources.
- III. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Virgin Islands Sanctions Unit;
- IV. report any findings to the Virgin Islands Sanctions Unit, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation; and
- V. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that the Virgin Islands Sanctions Unit may request. Information reported to the Virgin Islands Sanctions Unit may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 6. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.
